

Matchprint™ Professional Server PPD - Mac

PostScript Printer Descriptions (PPDs) are programs that tell the application programs you use on your computer how to communicate with your printer. Without drivers, each application would have to contain information about every type of printer that you might use. Instead, applications simply send the data to the printer driver you've selected and the driver tells the printer what to do.

Download **DocuColor 12 Mac PPD.sit**, to your Macintosh, open it using Stuffit Expander™, and place DocuColor 12 in the Printer Descriptions folder within the Extensions folder of the System Folder.

Macintosh Printer Drivers should be installed on all your Macintosh Workstations.

The download consists of:

Instructions

From the Apple/Chooser menu

1. Select a LaserWriter or Adobe PS Printer from the Chooser menu.
2. Select the spooler you created as the PostScript Printer.
3. Press Create.
4. After the Chooser tries to automatically find the DocuColor 12 PPD, press the Other PPD... button.
5. Select the Matchprint Professional Server printer description file DocuColor 12 from the Printer Descriptions folder within the Extensions folder within the Systems Folder and press Select.
6. Press OK at the Installable options window. An icon of a printer with a "rainbow" page will be placed to the left of the spooler name.
7. Close the Chooser.

Printing from the Desktop Application:

1. From the Print Menu ensure your settings are appropriate.
2. Select the spooler you created as the Printer and the appropriate paper size as the Paper in the Page Setup menu.
3. Select Matchprint for Xerox DocuColor 12) as the Printer Description and the appropriate paper size as the Page Size in the Setup menu.
